

## EMPLOYMENT AT A GLANCE...

- There were 22,446 residents employed in Q3 2019, up .7% from the previous quarter.
- Employment was up 5% compared to a year ago and up 9.2% compared to two years ago.
- There are 2,704 more residents currently employed compared to the employment adjustment in Q1 10, an increase of 13.7%.
- Over the past two years, employment has increased seven out of eight quarters.


## **3RD QUARTER TREND**

Employment was at its highest level since the base year of 2008 with over 22k residents employed.

Employment has continued a significant growth period which started in Q1 2017, increasing a total of 10 out of 11 quarters. Looking over just the past two years, employment has increased seven out of eight quarters or 9.2% with nearly 1,900 more residents currently employed.

Looking forward, 37% of local business leaders expect to increase their employment levels over the next 12 months, while 59% expect levels to remain the same.
