



TOT AT A GLANCE...



- Revenue was up 6.8% from a year ago and up 24.5% from two years ago.
- Revenue is up 42.9% or over \$30k from the base year of Q1 2008.
- TOT revenue is at its second highest level since Q1 2008.





3RD QUARTER TREND

Transient Occupancy Tax revenue (hotel bed tax) was just over \$100k in Q3 2019, up 2.7% following a decrease in the prior quarter. Current revenue is at the second highest grossing level since the base year of Q1 2008.

TOT has continued to show a strong upward trend over the past, up 42.9% since that time. Looking over just the past two years, total revenue has increased six of eight quarters and is up 24.5% or nearly \$20k. Over the past year, revenue increased three out of four quarters and is up 6.8% or nearly \$6,400 overall.

Overall, TOT has continued to positively impact the local economy.
