



EMPLOYMENT AT A GLANCE...



- Employment was down 3.2% compared to a year ago and up 2.6% compared to two years ago.
- Since 2010, first quarter employment has decreased 4 out of 10 years.
- Compared to 2010, employment was up 10.8% with over 2,100 more residents employed.




1ST QUARTER TREND

Employment was down 2% in Q1 2020 with 21,806 residents employed. This was the third quarterly decrease over the past year following a record high in Q1 2019.

Local employment started a strong growth period in Q1 2017 and peaked in Q1 2019. In those two years, employment increased eight consecutive quarters with 2,256 more residents working, up a total of 11.2%. Compared to the record high, Q1 2020 employment was down 3.2%.

Impacts from COVID-19 are expected to become more visible in upcoming reports as data becomes available.
