

TOT AT A GLANCE...


- TOT revenue was \$98,802, up 7.6% from the previous quarter.
- Current revenue is at the highest level since Q1 08, now 48.7%, or \$28,273 beyond a full recovery.
- Revenue is up 17.9% from one year ago, and up 23.2% from two years ago.
- Q3 16 TOT revenue is up \$32,333 since the recession low point in Q4 10.

3RD QUARTER TREND

Transient Occupancy Tax revenue has increased for the fourth quarter in a row, up 7.6% from a year ago. This is the first time we have seen a third quarter increase in TOT revenue since 2011.

Revenue is currently at its highest level since Q1 08, now 40.1% beyond a full recovery when compared to the pre-recession level. TOT revenue has continued a strong recovery over the years, with no signs of slowing down. Current revenue level is up 48.7% since the recession low in Q4 10.

With the busy holiday season upon us, we expect to see this component continue to improve the local economy.
