
Economic Index



EMPLOYMENT AT A Glance...

There were a seasonally adjusted 20,648 residents employed in Q2 16, up 50 or .2% since Q1 16.

There were 11,168 or 117.8% more people employed in Q2 16 than our lowest point in Q4 09.


Q2 16 is up 10,573 residents employed since the index started in Q1 08, and 905 higher than the significant economic jump in Q2 10.

2ND QUARTER TREND

Employment figures for El Dorado Hills increased slightly in Q2 16, remaining high and consistent. With 20,648 residents employed, El Dorado Hills increased .2% from the previous quarter. El Dorado County as a whole increased .1% as well.

Q1 16 and Q2 15 had the same employment figures; making El Dorado Hills have 50 more employed residents compared to the last quarter and this time last year. There are 117.8%, or 11,168, more residents employed than the recession low in Q4 09 and 104.9% higher than when the index started in Q1 08.

El Dorado Hills has seen stable labor rates and positive economic trends. We expect this component to remain for employed residents.
