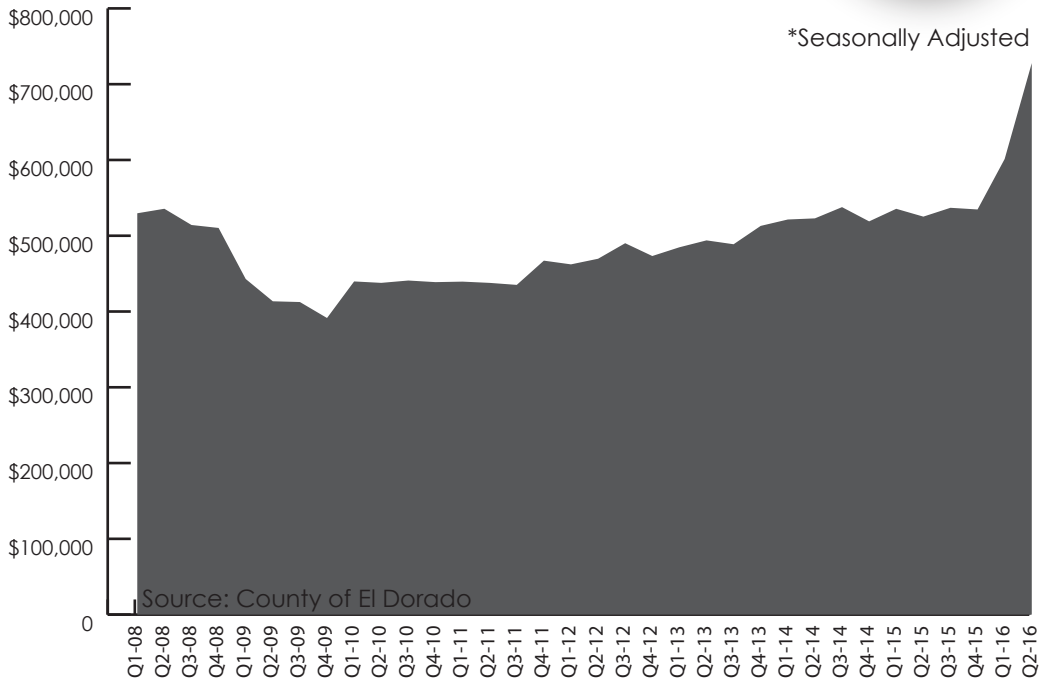

SALES TAX AT A GLANCE...



Q2 16 Sales Tax revenue was \$727,820, up 21% from the previous quarter and up 38.5% from a year ago.

Revenue has increased five out of the last eight quarters on a seasonally adjusted basis.

Sales Tax revenue is now \$198k, or 37.4% beyond a full recovery when compared to our base year of 2008.

Sales Tax is the third most recovered component of the Index, having increased over 85.9% from the recession low in Q4 09.

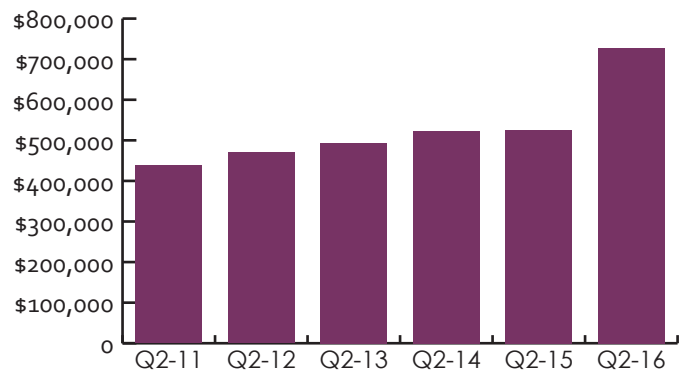
2ND QUARTER TREND

Sales Tax revenue is now at its highest point since Q1 08 with over \$727k received in Q2 16, up again for the second consecutive quarter.

Over the last two years, five out of the eight quarters have increased after seasonal adjustment, suggesting some possible continued volatility moving forward. Fortunately, feedback from local business leaders in the July 2016 El Dorado Hills Business Confidence Survey™ suggests an optimistic future ahead. The results show 93% of local business leaders expect sales to remain the same or increase in the next 12 months.
