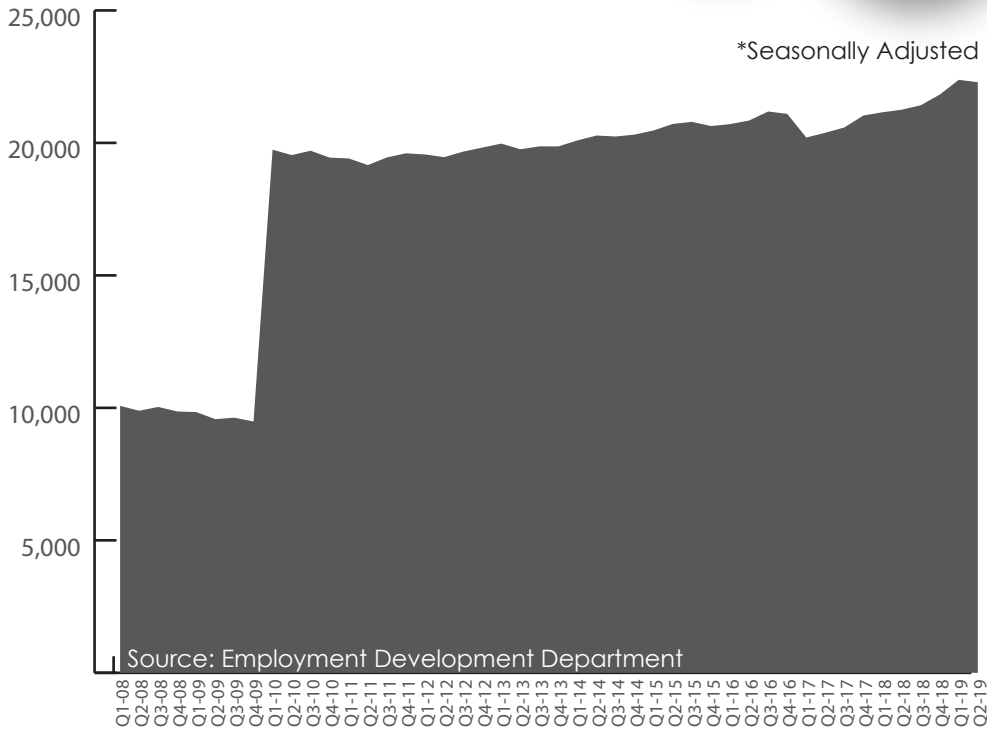

EMPLOYMENT AT A GLANCE...



There were 22,290 residents employed in Q2 2019, down .4% from the previous quarter.

Employment up 4.9% compared to a year ago and up 9.3% compared to two years ago.

Over the past two years, employment has increased seven out of eight quarters.

This is the first decrease in the second quarter since 2013.

2ND QUARTER TREND

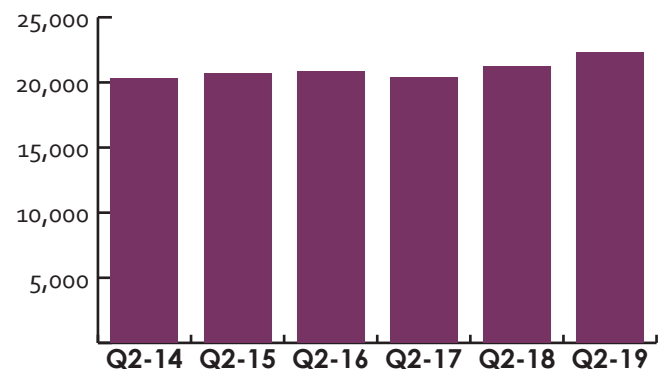
Over 22k residents were employed in Q2 2019, the second highest quarterly employment level since 2008.

Employment was down .4% in Q2 2019, the first decrease following a strong period of growth over the past two years. When compared back to two years ago, current employment is up 9.3% with nearly 1,900 more residents currently working.

In July 2019, 27% of local business leaders stated they expect to increase their employment levels over the next 12 months, while 64% expect levels to remain the same.
