## El Dorado Hills Art, Beer & Wine Festival returns for Mother's Day Weekend

(EL DORADO HILLS, CA) – One of the areas' largest events, El Dorado Hills Art, Beer & Wine Festival, is coming back to the El Dorado Hills Town Center Mother's Day weekend. The El Dorado Hills Chamber of Commerce has produced this regional event since 2003, and is pleased to present the Festival again in collaboration with their <u>Premier Partners</u>, event sponsors, artists, breweries, wineries, community supporters, and volunteers. The El Dorado Hills Art, Beer & Wine Festival will be held on Saturday, May 13 – Sunday, May 14, 2023, from 11 AM – 5 PM, with beer and wine tasting from 12 – 4:30 PM. Admittance is free and tasting glasses/wristbands can be purchased for \$35 in advance or \$45 at the gate.
